Uniform Chaperone Rules/Duties; Revised and Effective, 2017
- Teams:** Each team is to consist of three (3) or four (4) riders, one (1) stable manager, one (1) C advisor (optional), one (1) chaperone, and one (1) coach. One (1) of the riders is to be designated as captain and acts as spokesperson. Teams may be of mixed D levels. Three (3) adult volunteers are REQUIRED per team. Additional volunteers are welcome. Coaches may be shared amongst teams.
- Clubs may also send in individual entries and organizers will put teams together.
- Divisions:** Competitors must ride according to their rating level.
